

## Single Family (SF-3) Zoning Districts – Quick Sheet

To verify your zoning, please see the Town Zoning Map. Additionally, you can find references to all the major development standards in Sections 3.03 & 3.06 of the Unified Development Ordinance.

## Single Family – 3 Zoning District (SF-3)

The SF-3, Single-Family Residential district is intended for low density residential uses on large and medium size lots. The minimum lot size of one (1) acre. The maximum base density is one (1) dwelling units per gross acre. For the provision of flexible development opportunities, the SF-3, Single-Family Residential district is intended to be used a base zoning district for planned residential developments. This district is appropriate where low-density urban development is desired and where public services exist or could reasonably be extended to the development.
